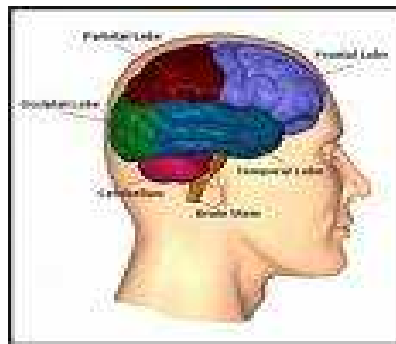


RETURNING MILITARY PERSONNEL: ASK YOURSELF TWO QUESTIONS...
